

## Blowout Score Procedures

Division	Goal +/-	Rule
<b>3rd/4th Grade</b>	5	Once a team goes up by five goals, they must remove one player from the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player.
	6	Once a team goes up by six goals, they must remove a second player off the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player. Teams will continue to keep two players off the field if they have a goal differential of six or more.
<b>5th/6th Grade</b>	5	Once a team goes up by five goals, they must remove one player from the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player.
	6	Once a team goes up by six goals, they must remove a second player off the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player. Teams will continue to keep two players off the field if they have a goal differential of six or more.
<b>7th/9th &amp; Co-Ed</b>	5	Once a team goes up by five goals, they must remove one player from the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player.
	6	Once a team goes up by six goals, they must remove a second player off the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player.
	7	Once a team goes up by seven goals, they must remove a third player off the field. If the opposition scores a goal, they may return one player. Teams will continue to keep two players off the field if they have a goal differential of seven or more.
